

HOW TO MEMORIZE SCRIPTURE

One of the best ways to get to know God is to study His words in the Bible. Memorizing Scripture is important because it helps us internalize important truths, and find comfort and encouragement when life gets crazy.

But memorizing is hard. (Is there a forgot password option for Bible verses?) So when it comes to helping our *kids* memorize Scripture, it's difficult to know where to start—especially if it's something that's not part of our lives either.

Choose your own verses to memorize or cut out the verse cards on the attached sheet. These are verses that you and your kids can memorize **together!** Here are some suggestions on how to make that happen!

MEMORIZING TIPS:

- Write down or print off the Scripture and place it on the front of the refrigerator. Whenever someone in the family opens its door, they have to recite the memory verse out loud.
- Give each word or phrase a hand motion, using them each time you say the verse aloud.
- Write the verse on everyone's bathroom mirror using a dry erase marker.
- Have each person in the family memorize parts of the verse. Get together and have each person say their part in order.
- Write parts of the verse on note cards and scramble them up. Take turns sorting them into the correct order.
- During the day, send the verse to one another in a text message, voice memo, or video.
